

THE ROBERT E. REITER PRIZE FOR CRITICAL ANALYSIS

This award is designed to recognize critical/scholarly writing at the undergraduate level. To be eligible for this award, the applicant must (1) be/have been an undergraduate student at Ohio State (*open to all undergraduates, regardless of major, as well as to recent graduates from Ohio State*) and (2) have completed a critical or scholarly essay as part of an Ohio State English course at the 3000-level or higher during the immediately previous Fall, Summer, or Spring semesters (*essays completed during earlier semesters will not be considered*). The recipient of this award will receive an invitation to the English Department's annual awards ceremony, which will take place in late April, and a \$500 honorarium.
