

THE ARNOLD & FRANCES SHAPIRO INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Arnold and Frances Shapiro International Scholarship was established by the late Arnie Shapiro, Ohio State English Professor from 1962-1991, and his wife, Fran, to help English majors and our minors participate in the department's study abroad programs. Individual awards are available up to \$1,000.

Eligibility: Recipients of the Shapiro International Scholarship must be participating in either English 4400 Literary Locations or the four-week Literature and Culture of London summer program held during May.

Application Requirements: Students who meet the above criteria should submit an application consisting of the following:

(1) This completed form

(2) A *one-page, single-spaced statement* (Word doc or PDF file) that explains (a) why their chosen study abroad program is important to them, (b) how they expect to benefit from the experience and (c) how the award will help them financially afford to participate in the program. **Statements should remain anonymous**

(3) Letter of recommendation from *one course instructor*. Instructors may submit letters directly to Pablo Tanguay at tanguay.1@osu.edu.

Submission Procedure: These materials should be **emailed as an attachment with the email subject line "Shapiro scholarship application"** to Pablo Tanguay at tanguay.1@osu.edu. **No hard copies will be accepted.**

Deadline to Apply: Applications for this scholarship should be submitted within two weeks of the study abroad program's application deadline.

Review Process: Applications will be evaluated on the strength of the statement (clarity, significance of the specific study-abroad program to the student's academic and personal growth, and financial need); letter of recommendation, and advising report. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the English Department's annual spring awards ceremony.
